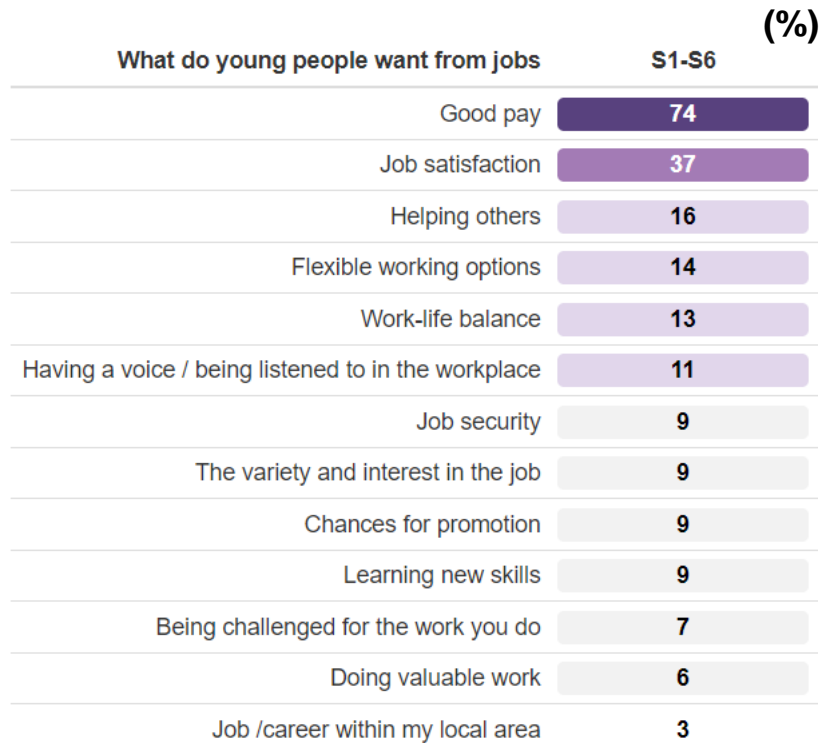

Horizons

- Encourage all students to think about their future pathways when they leave Alford Academy and to prepare them fully for what lies ahead.
- Provide opportunities for gaining extra qualifications / wider achievements to “stand out from the crowd”.
- Deliver focussed learning sessions using external partnerships, including opportunities for mock interviews.
- Encourage all students to take part in work experience / volunteering in a field of interest. Work placements can be scheduled on a Tuesday to minimise any disruption to SQA courses and loss of learning and teaching.

Students will have the option to study in school or at home using the skills they have developed in the past year using blended learning.
